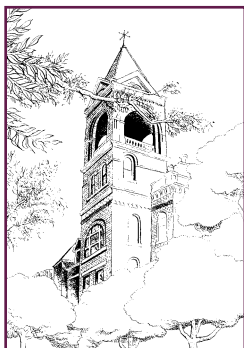


Agnes Scott College Class of 1955
